
## **Book Club Guide**

## Entanglement: A Hollywood Lights Novel, by Katie Rose Guest Pryal Prepared by the Author

- 1. In what way is Los Angeles like a character in the novel? When Greta first arrives in L.A. at the beginning of the book, she notices the climate and how it is different from the climate back home in North Carolina. Are there other ways that Los Angeles itself seems to play a role in the story?
- 2. Why do you think Sandy befriends Greta? He's a famous and wealthy movie star. What does she have to offer him?
- 3. What is Greta's biggest fear, do you think? Is that why she gets so upset with Daphne on Halloween? Is it fair for Greta to get so upset with Daphne?
- 4. There's a line in the book that happens when Sandy and Greta are having a conversation: "He could speak the truth because people had to listen. She spoke the truth because she couldn't bear to lie." What insight does this line give you into the characters of Sandy and Greta, and why they might have become friends?



- 5. Why do you think Daphne does what she does with Timmy after Greta runs off with Sandy? Were you angry with Daphne? Do you think Daphne did it because she was angry with Greta? Or were the reasons more complicated?
- 6. Do you think Greta should forgive Daphne for what she did with Timmy? Would you have forgiven her?
- 7. Who is your favorite character in *Entanglement?* Why? Who is your least favorite character? Why?
- 8. Did you have a best friend? Do you still? Do you see any elements of your friendship in the friendship that Greta and Daphne had?
